REACH (EC) No 1907/2006 is a European Union regulation concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of Chemicals. It came into force on 1st June 2007 and replaced a number of European Directives and Regulations with a single system.

The list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC's) are revised regularly and are defined by the European Chemical Agency here: -

As per the regulations - West Control Solutions will declare to our customers any of the SVHC's present in articles where these are above 0.1% w/w.

West Control Solutions continues to work with our suppliers to ensure they are aware of their requirements under the regulation, to ensure we receive information on (component) articles and substances used in our (finished) articles.

We will continue to monitor all further obligations with regards to REACH and any consequences of Brexit.
